Family & Friends

Many of your close family members and friends may be helping you with your move. For the others, consider making a list and using social media or mailing a note with your new address.

Postal Service

After family and friends, arguably one of the most important places to advise of your move is the USPS. To forward your mail on a specified date, simply fill out a <u>Change of Address Form here</u> or at your local post office.

Physicians & Other Healthcare Providers

Make sure to update your new contact information for your primary care physician, dentist and any specialists you regularly see.

Utilities

Don't forget to have services disconnected on or just after moving day for electricity, gas, water, telephone, cable, internet, trash removal and other municipal services.

Internal Revenue Service

To ensure you recieve your tax return, fiscal notes and other documents, print out and mail in the IRS' <u>Change of Address form here.</u>

Passport, Driver's License or ID Cards

Don't forget to update these important documents, if applicable.
